The spirit of the Catholic School League is to encourage participation, strengthen self-esteem and have fun while playing the sport of interest. All coaches in the CSL must adhere to a *Responsible Coaching Code of Ethics* and we expect our parents and fans to set a positive example for our children to follow as well.

- RESPECT authority and teach the players to respect authority by your example
- Never make personal remarks to officials. Those who mistreat or disrespect our officials will be asked to leave the facility.
- Always treat the facility you are in with RESPECT.
- Be a POSITIVE EXAMPLE for all our athletes. They look to adults for guidance, don't let them down.
- BE A GREAT AMBASSADOR FOR YOUR SCHOOL. Others will judge your school by your actions.
- Teach your athletes to be Gracious Winners, and accept defeat in stride
- Never yell at, 'boo' or 'heckle' an opposing player, team, coach, or referee
- Artificial noise makers are not allowed in our facilities or at any CSL event.
 Deliberate noise during VB serves or BB free-throws is not allowed and considered unsportsmanlike conduct.
- This is YOUTH SPORTS! Kids come first! NOT the egos of adults.
- The NB CSL will not tolerate unsportsmanlike behavior from anyone.

All spectators and fans are expected to conduct themselves with the highest level of sportsmanship at all times. Any on-site Athletic Director or referee has the authority to remove any person from our facilities who does not comply with our Spectator Code of Conduct. Any person removed from any game risks being sanctioned by the NB CSL board of directors and banned from attending future games.
